The John Pounds Community Trust then took over the space and initiated the Treadgolds Project to create new spaces for well-being and creativity. The 'Treadgolds Courtyard Garden' is already operational, and the trust has established a special meeting and well-being space in the adjoining Victorian Warehouse, which received the RIBA South Award in 2022. The incredible warehouse space, with its high vaulted ceiling and beautiful natural light, is also used for exhibitions, performance art, and other community-based activities, creating a unique cultural hub.
